Core Message Structure

Teenagers Under Attack?

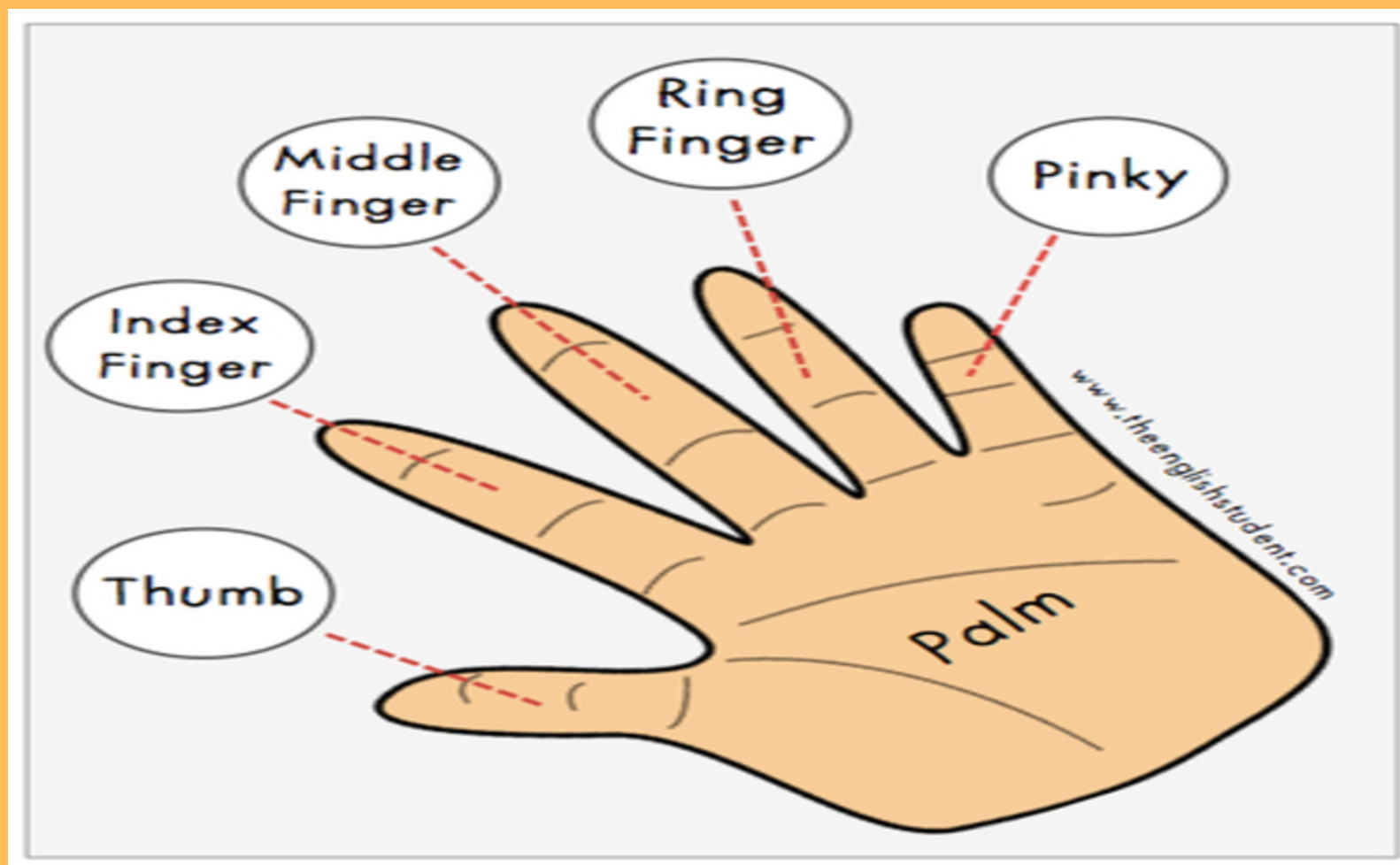
Teenagers today are attacked on every side by the world's influence. Participants to share some of the attacks they face.

Scripture Commands Us

Teachings of Jesus in Matthew 18:1-14

1. The age which children should be evangelized is often debated.
 - Jesus begins this section speaking of a little child (v.2) Little child = paidion
 - Mark 9:36 shows the child was very little – “He took him in His arms.”
 2. Adults are required to enter the kingdom as little children, depending humbly on God (vv. 3-4) Little children, little children = paidion.
 - Adults must return to childhood attitudes, not actions.
 - Children live in a natural environment of dependence.
 3. The Lord Jesus placed great value on a little child (v. 5) Little child = paidion.
 - Jesus settled forever the question as to whether little children can believe and be saved (v. 6) Little ones = mikros.
 - Said “....little ones which believe in me....”
 - Jesus affirmed this was saving faith; “believe in me” the same words used in John 3:16; Acts 16:31.
 - Jesus warns us not to offend believing children.
 4. Jesus gives a second warning about regarding children lightly (v. 10) Little ones = mikros
 5. Jesus taught the importance of one child (v. 12)
 - Rejoicing over each one saved (v. 13).
 - Not His will that one should perish (v.14) Little ones = mikros

Core Message Structure



Sin (Ask the Holy Spirit for Divine appointments to share the Gospel)

My Index Finger reminds me of Sin

Audience Understanding

Song Time The Teenager's Faith &

- Know your audience: different backgrounds, beliefs & questions
- Explain Gospel terms simply — avoid church jargon.
- Common backgrounds: first-time hearers, churched, sceptics.

The Gospel Outline

I want to tell you the most amazing story ever.

Q&A and Misconceptions

Handling Questions with Respect & Confidence

Great sharers are great listeners! When someone asks a tough question, stay calm, and show them you care about their journey to truth.

Common Questions Teens Ask

"Why does God allow suffering?" "Is Jesus the only way?" "What about people who never heard of Jesus?" "How do I know the Bible is true?" These are real questions. Prepare honest, humble answers!

Tips for Calm Responses

Listen fully before you respond. Take a breath, say "That's a great question!" and answer simply. It's okay to say "I don't know, but let's find out together."

Do's & Don'ts in Q & A

✓ DO: Listen well, stay humble, use scripture gently, admit uncertainty. ✗ DON'T: Argue, dismiss feelings, rush answers, or use big church words that confuse people.



Guided Role-Play

Facilitator-Led Practice for Gospel Clarity

🎭 Volunteers act out Gospel sharing scenarios in front of the group.

💬 Group Discussion: What was clear? What could be improved?

✅ Feedback Prompts:

- 2 things done well
- 1 thing to strengthen

🔄 Rotate roles — everyone gets a turn to share and reflect!
